Dear Sir/Madam

I started using Aspen three years ago as a direct result of chainsaw milling. Being so close to the fumes of a large chainsaw was giving me headaches and making me feel nauseous.

I'd had enough, so I got my first load of Aspen 2-stroke and these symptoms disappeared overnight. Shortly afterwards I also switched to their bio oil. You don't realize how bad normal mineral oil smells until you have to use it again.

These days my chainsaw milling is limited by muscle fatigue rather than fume fatigue.

And there are other benefits. No more stopping work for a trip to the garage to refuel. You always get a 50-to-1 [fuel-to-oil] mix, so it is better for your tools – and there is no chance of using fuel that someone has forgotten to mix with oil. Machines always run well no matter how long they have spent in the corner of a shed due to the long – three-to-five year – shelf life of Aspen alkylate petrol.

And with the new non-spill filler, there is no waste when transferring fuel from one container to the next.

It still makes the wallet smart when a new shipment of fuel is needed, but you get what you pay for in my opinion. Anyway, the long-term health benefits, for man and machine, balance the extra cost.

I would never go back to normal fuel and self mixing.
